All participants will be expected to follow the COVID-19 guidelines in effect at the time of these trials to ensure that the trial environment is as safe as possible.

Everyone in attendance will be required to sign a COVID-19 Waiver of Liability. Please DO NOT send the waiver with your entries. It will be available to preview on DOTC's website www.DOTCLynchburg.org and will be emailed with the judging program. You may submit the signed waiver to the Trial Secretary by email starting February 11 or bring it with you to the trials.

We will be using separate clearly marked entrance and exit doors.

Face coverings should be worn in the building. The club is leaving the decision to wear a mask while in the ring competing up to the exhibitor.

These one-ring trials will allow for socially distanced indoor crating.

Effective January 1, 2021, the AKC Obedience Regulations have been permanently amended to specify the use of cones instead of stewards as the posts in the Figure Eight exercise.

There will be multiple walkthrough groups for rally classes with large entries.

You will need to bring your own food & drinks.

All persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk. By virtue of entering these trials, the exhibitor has indicated acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

These trials will be closed to the general public.

All OBEDIENCE & RALLY classes will be judged in the heated Boonsboro Ruritan Club building. The regulation-sized ring (at least 40'x 50') will be fully matted with DOTC's interlocking non-slip foam mats and enclosed with ring gates.

COVID-19 Policies

These procedures may be modified as conditions change. If you have questions or concerns, contact the Trial Secretary.

By entering these trials, the exhibitor agrees to abide by DOTC's COVID-19 guidelines, along with any state, local and facility guidelines that pertain to these events.

In accordance with state guidelines, everyone attending these trials is asked to wear a face covering indoors, wash your hands frequently, and maintain 6 feet of distance from those who are not in your household.

We must have a signed COVID-19 Waiver of Liability for each person in attendance. The waiver will be posted at www.DOTCLynchburg.org and with the event information on the AKC website. The waiver will be emailed with the judging program. You may submit the signed waiver to the Trial Secretary by email starting February 11, or bring it with you to the trials.

One ring enclosed with ring gates will be used for these trials. It will be centered to allow for socially distanced crating on both sides.

We expect that we will be able to provide indoor crating space for all exhibitors. Please bring your own chairs.

We will be using one set of doors to enter the building and a different set of doors to exit the building. These will be clearly marked.

There will be a check-in table separate from the judge's table. The Trial Secretary or another DOTC member will verify that we have your waiver. You will receive your armband(s) there for the day. Prepaid catalogs will be picked up at the check-in table. A very limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase on the trial weekend.

Hand sanitizer will be provided at various locations in the building.

Printed copies of the rally course maps will be available in paper trays on a separate table. DOTC pens will be provided for all exhibitors. You can use the stylus on the end of the pen to pull out the maps you need. Course maps will be posted on the wall. You can take pictures of them if you prefer.

If a rally class has a large number of handlers, they will be split into groups for the walkthrough.

Our judges and volunteers will wear masks at all times. Exhibitors may lower or remove their masks while in the ring competing.

Ribbons and prizes will not be awarded in the ring. The judges may announce the scores. To receive your ribbons/rosettes and prizes, you will go to the club table one at a time where a club member will assist you.

The trial results will be posted on a wall. You can take pictures of the results.

Food and drinks will not be available for purchase. You will need to bring your own lunch, snacks and drinks.

If you have COVID-19 or its symptoms, or you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within 14 days prior to the trial weekend, do not attend these trials.

In the event you are diagnosed with COVID-19 and need to withdraw from these trials after the closing date and prior to the start date of February 13, 2021, a full refund will be provided with a doctor's note.

Telephone, fax and email entries cannot be accepted.

Entries without full fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. For email confirmation of receipt of entry, see entry form.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **not acceptable. Unsigned and illegible entries will not be accepted.**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$25 will be added to the amount of each returned check.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. **An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50** is required for each first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. These fees are included in the entry fees.

No refund for overpayment of fees if the error is less than \$10.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors after the published closing date.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

A refund of entry fees less a \$5 processing fee for each trial entered may be obtained for bitches that come in season or dogs injured after the close of entries. The Trial Secretary must receive a veterinarian's statement no later than one half hour prior to the start of judging the first class in the appropriate trial.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's trial catalog.

Each owner and agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a trial is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form.

The Dog Owners Training Club of Lynchburg and the Boonsboro Ruritan Club assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property.

EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS both inside the building and outdoors. Exhibitors who fail to comply may be excused from these events by the Trial Committee with no refund.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

In general, follow the signs to Rt. 501 North. Here are the details:

US 460 - From the West of Lynchburg: From 460, take the right-hand exit to 460 E Business (Timberlake Rd). Proceed for about 3 miles to Route 501. Exit onto 501 North and go about 2 miles to a traffic light at Rt. 221.
Continue straight on Rt. 501 N through the light at Rt. 221. At the next light, turn left to stay on Rt. 501 North. At the next light at Boonsboro Rd., turn left (still 501 N) and go about 2 miles. Turn left onto Coffee Road (Rt. 644) [Dollar General Store will be on the left] and go about 2 miles. The Boonsboro Ruritan Club Building is on the right.

US 460 - From the East of Lynchburg: Exit Rt. 460 at Candler's Mountain Rd (a right turn exit). Follow signs to Rt. 501 North (River Ridge Mall will be on your left, and La Quinta Inn will be on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr./Rt.221 *See italics above.*

US 29 - From the North of Lynchburg: After passing the town of Amherst, stay on Route 29 South. (Do not take Business Rt. 29 South). This is the limited-access Madison Heights Bypass. After crossing the James River, Rt. 29 will join Rt. 460 West. DO NOT take Rt. 501 North Business at Campbell Ave. Continue to Candler's Mountain Rd and follow signs for Rt. 501 North. (River Ridge Mall is on the left, and La Quinta Inn on the right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr./Rt.221. *See italics above.*

US 29 - From the South of Lynchburg: Follow Business Rt. 29 North into the city limits (pass River Ridge mall entrance on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North and proceed for about 3 miles to Rt. 221. *See italics above.*

- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience or Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
